The cost of attendance (COA) is an estimate of what it costs the typical student to attend college. It includes tuition and fees, room and board, and allowances for books, supplies, transportation, and personal expenses. *It is important for a student to budget and make wise decisions regarding how to utilize the financial aid funds they receive.*

The figures below are the estimated cost of attendance allowances for full-time Undergraduate and Graduate students at A&M-Texarkana for the 2010-2011 award year. In some situations, the Financial Aid Office may consider an increase to a student's budget on a case-by-case basis for certain costs such as, a one-time computer purchase, or unexpected medical expenses, child care, etc. If a student believes he/she has a situation that merits a budget increase, the student is encouraged to contact the Financial aid Office. A letter requesting an increase must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office as well as documentation to support the request.

Tuition and Fees – The average cost of tuition and fees for a typical student based on enrolling for 30 hours per year. The actual costs that a student incurs will vary depending on the student’s degree or certificate program. *All tuition and fees are pending final approval as of 4/23/2010.*

Books and Supplies – The average cost of books and supplies for a typical student for an entire academic year. (Above reflects Fall and Spring semesters)

Room and Board – A reasonable estimate of what it would cost to live in Texarkana while attending Texas A&M University-Texarkana. Actual costs may vary by individual choices related to location and circumstances.

Transportation – The average transportation costs a student may expect to incur to/from A&M-Texarkana for the Fall and Spring semesters as a fulltime student.

Personal and Misc. – The average personal costs a student may expect to incur to attend A&M-Texarkana during the Fall and Spring semesters as a fulltime student.
