AMENDMENT No. 2 TO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OFFICES AND SCANTRON CORPORATION

PROVIDER shall provide A&M System with evidence of its TX-RAMP compliance and certification within thirty (30) days of A&M System request and at least thirty (30) days prior to the start of any renewal term of this Agreement.

All other terms and conditions not hereby amended are to remain in full force and effect.
