









Exceptions to the Licensed Carry of Concealed Handguns at Texas A&M University-Texarkana

In accordance with state law, the licensed carry of concealed handguns will be allowed at Texas A&M University-Texarkana beginning on August 1, 2016. After consulting with students, staff members, and faculty, the following exceptions were proposed that take into account specific safety considerations of the Texas A&M University-Texarkana environment. The proposals were reviewed by the Texas A&M System Office of General Counsel, approved by the Chancellor for submission to the Board, and were considered and accepted by the Texas A&M System Board of Regents on April 27, 2016.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Premises where Programs for Minors, as defined and administered by System Regulation 24.01.06 and University Rule 24.01.06.H1, are held, including summer camps, workshops, conferences and other activities serving participants under the age of 18 - Premises on which interscholastic events are hosted by A&M-Texarkana and where minors are the primary participants/audience

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Premises where Programs for Minors, as defined and administered by System Regulation 24.01.06 and University Rule 24.01.06.H1, are held, including summer camps, workshops, conferences and other activities serving participants under the age of 18
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Specific premises in which formal hearings are being conducted pursuant to university rules or procedures for faculty and staff disciplinary matters, student conduct proceedings, and academic grievances
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Texas A&M University-Texarkana has adopted this standard
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Any campus premises leased by the university to a third party, if the third party determines to prohibit the concealed carry of handguns on the premises and provides effective notice pursuant to Section 30.06, Penal Code - Testing Center
