



Exceptions to the Licensed Carry of Concealed Handguns at Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory

In accordance with state law, the licensed carry of concealed handguns will be allowed at Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory beginning on August 1, 2016. After consulting with students, staff members, and faculty, the following exceptions were proposed that take into account specific safety considerations of the Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory environment. The proposals were reviewed by the Texas A&M System Office of General Counsel, approved by the Chancellor for submission to the Board, and were considered and accepted by the Texas A&M System Board of Regents on April 27, 2016.

	- High hazard research areas and laboratories where the presence of high hazard materials or operations creates a significant risk of catastrophic harm due to a negligent discharge, including, but not limited to, BioSafety Level 3 laboratories and areas having high magnetic fields, such as MRI research facilities
