Dear A&M System Training Coordinators,

I am pleased to announce the availability of a new online course in TrainTraq: *Bloodborne Pathogens Online Training – System Version* (course no. 2111525). This course, which was developed in conjunction with the A&M System Office of Safety, is designed to meet all of the training requirements of the Texas Department of State Health Services and, where applicable, U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) rules. It can be used both as initial training and as an annual refresher. System members may choose to assign this course to selected employees to meet bloodborne pathogens training requirements. A screenshot of the course details page from TrainTraq is attached.

In addition, at the request of the Office of Safety, we have created a course in TrainTraq called *Hepatitis B Vaccination Form* (course no. 2111524). This course has no content (the course type is "other"); it is intended to be used as a mechanism for documenting completion of the Hepatitis B Vaccination Form. A&M System member Safety offices may choose to assign this course to employees and then manually record a completion after the form has been received (course details and sample notification attached). A completion indicates *only* that the safety office has received a form from the employee; it does not and should not contain any information about how the employee responded.

System members will not be required to use either of these courses; they have been made available primarily as tools that your Safety office can use as needed. Your Safety Officer will be responsible for identifying employees at your System member who should be assigned the course. Please assist him or her in making assignments and monitoring completions as needed. If you need help with making assignments, customizing e-mail notifications, or anything else related to using this course, please let me know.
