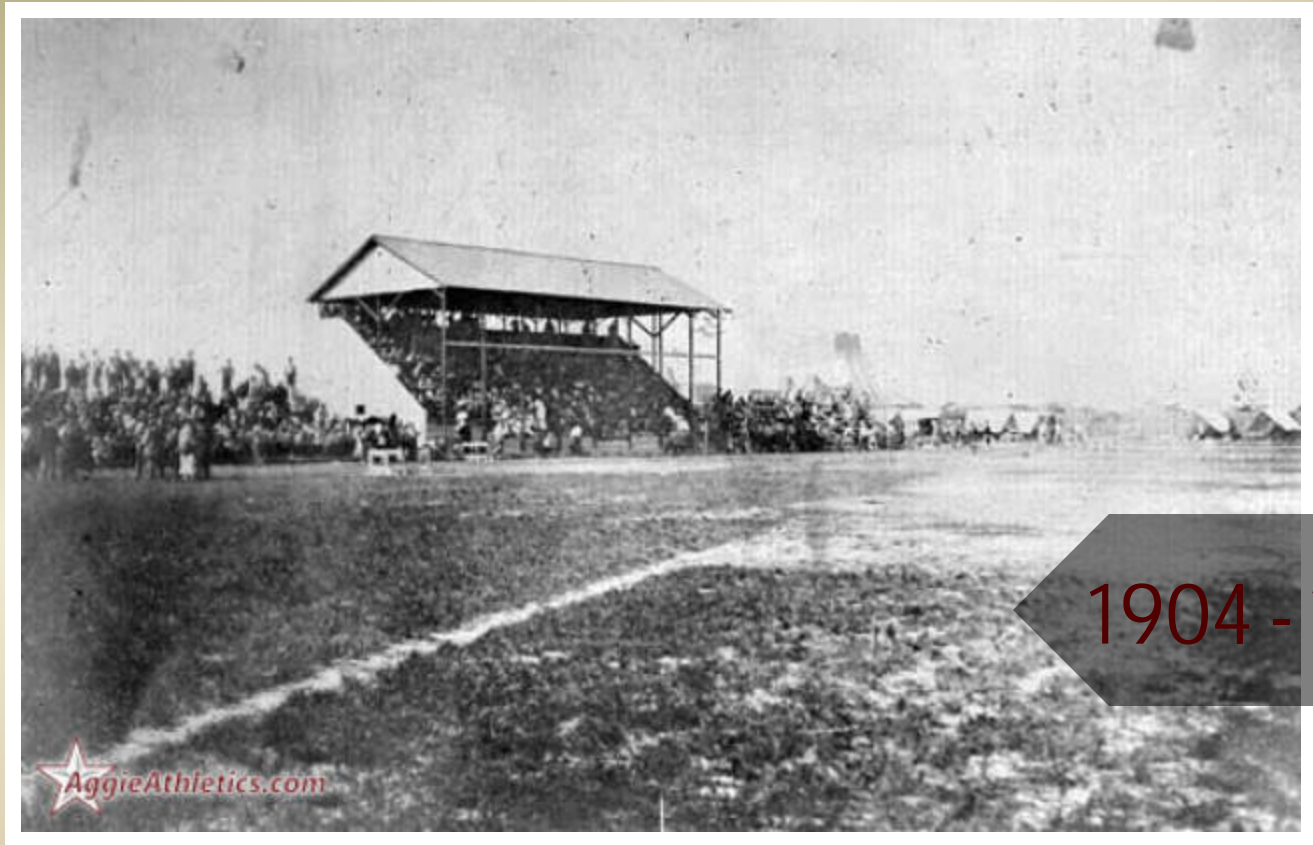

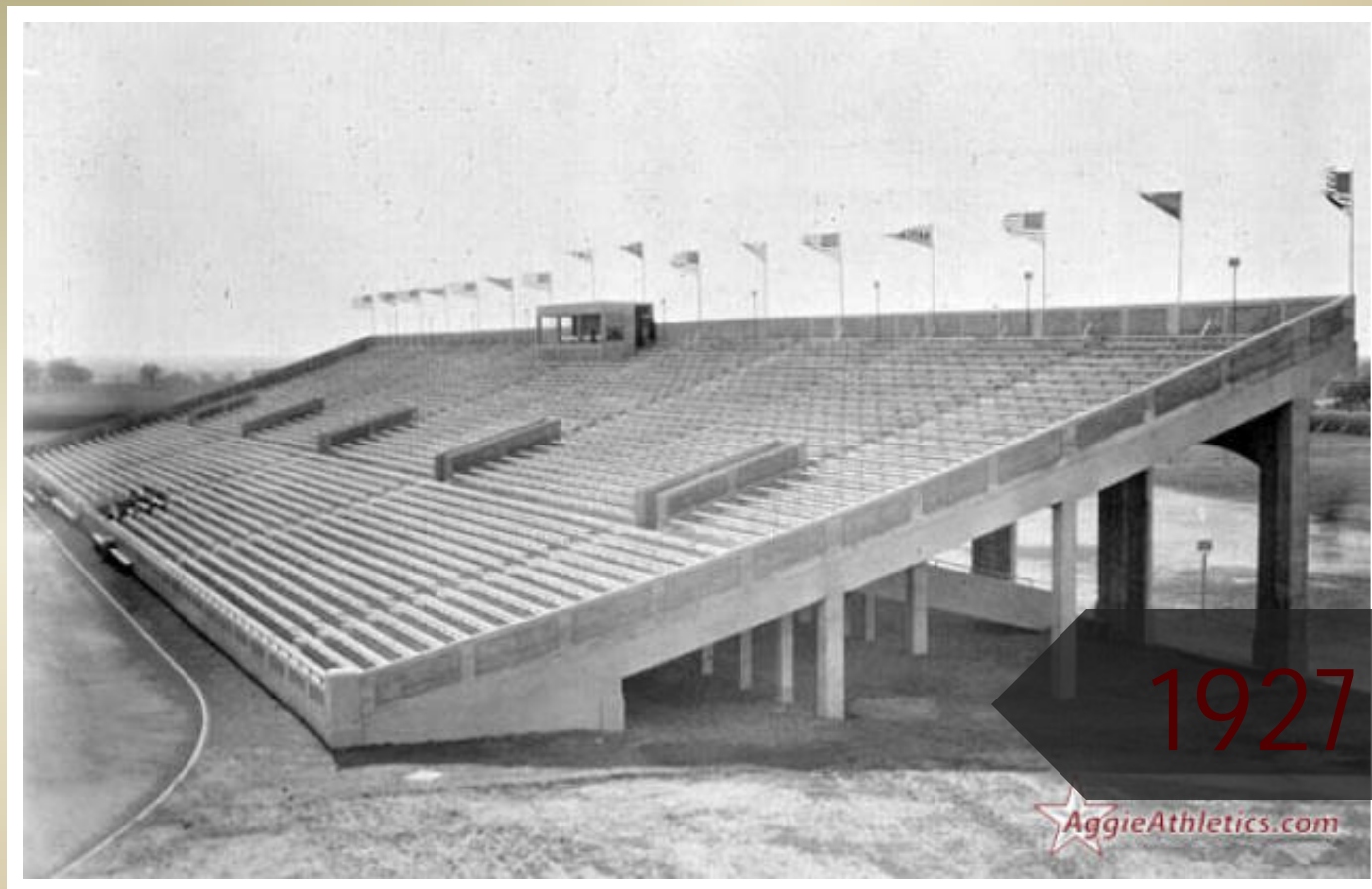

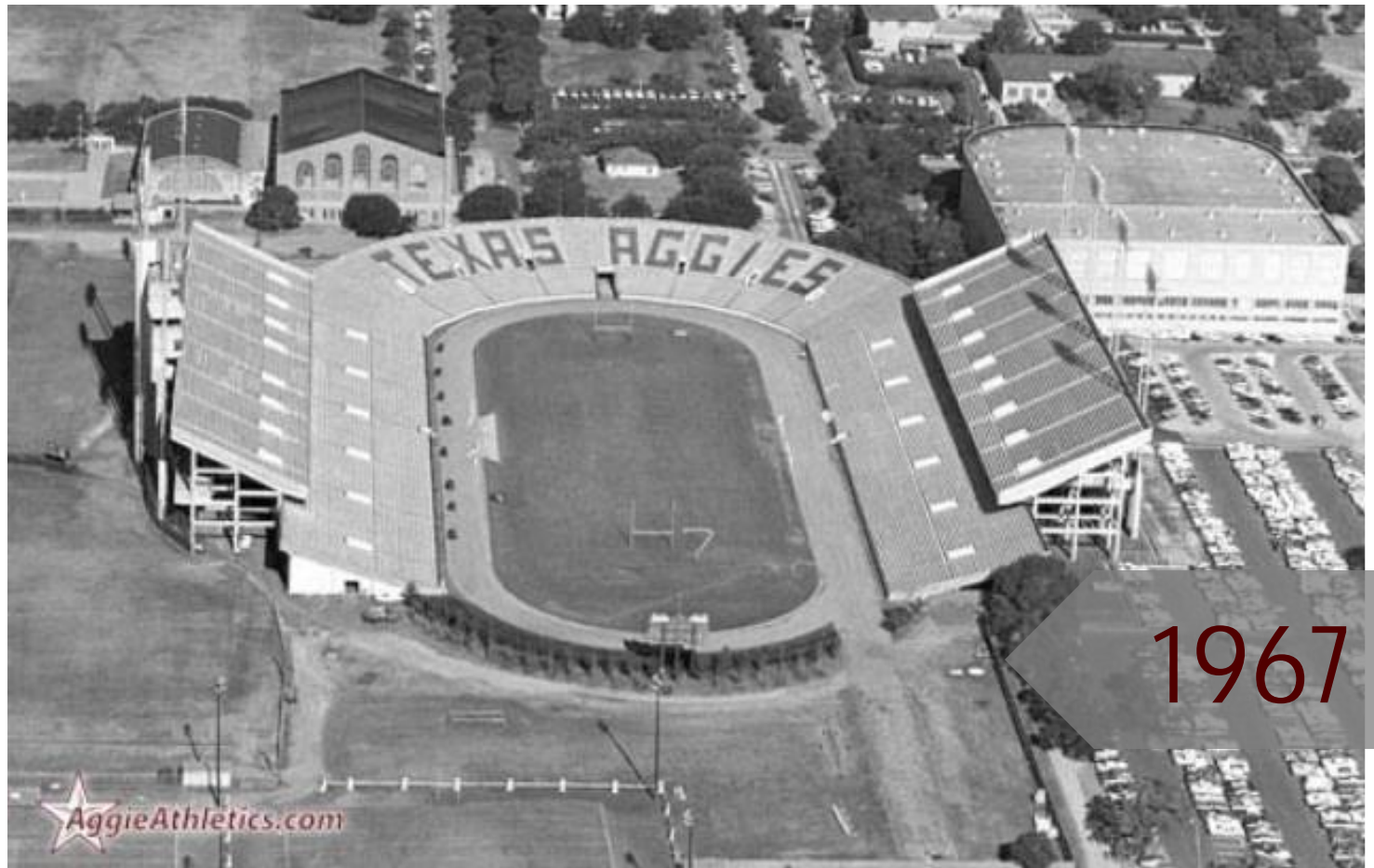

Kyle Field

- Manhours Worked: 2.24M (as of end of January)
- Debris removed: 6,500 semi-truck loads
- Structural Steel: 29.6M lbs.
- Concrete Slab poured: 992,480 sq. ft.
- Face Brick: 2,112,750 each
- Foundation Piers drilled: 1,650 each
- Glass: 63,000 sq. ft.
- Paint: 9,600 gallons
- Doors: 1,364 each
- Televisions: 1,255 each
- Electrical Wire: 4,480,000 linear ft.

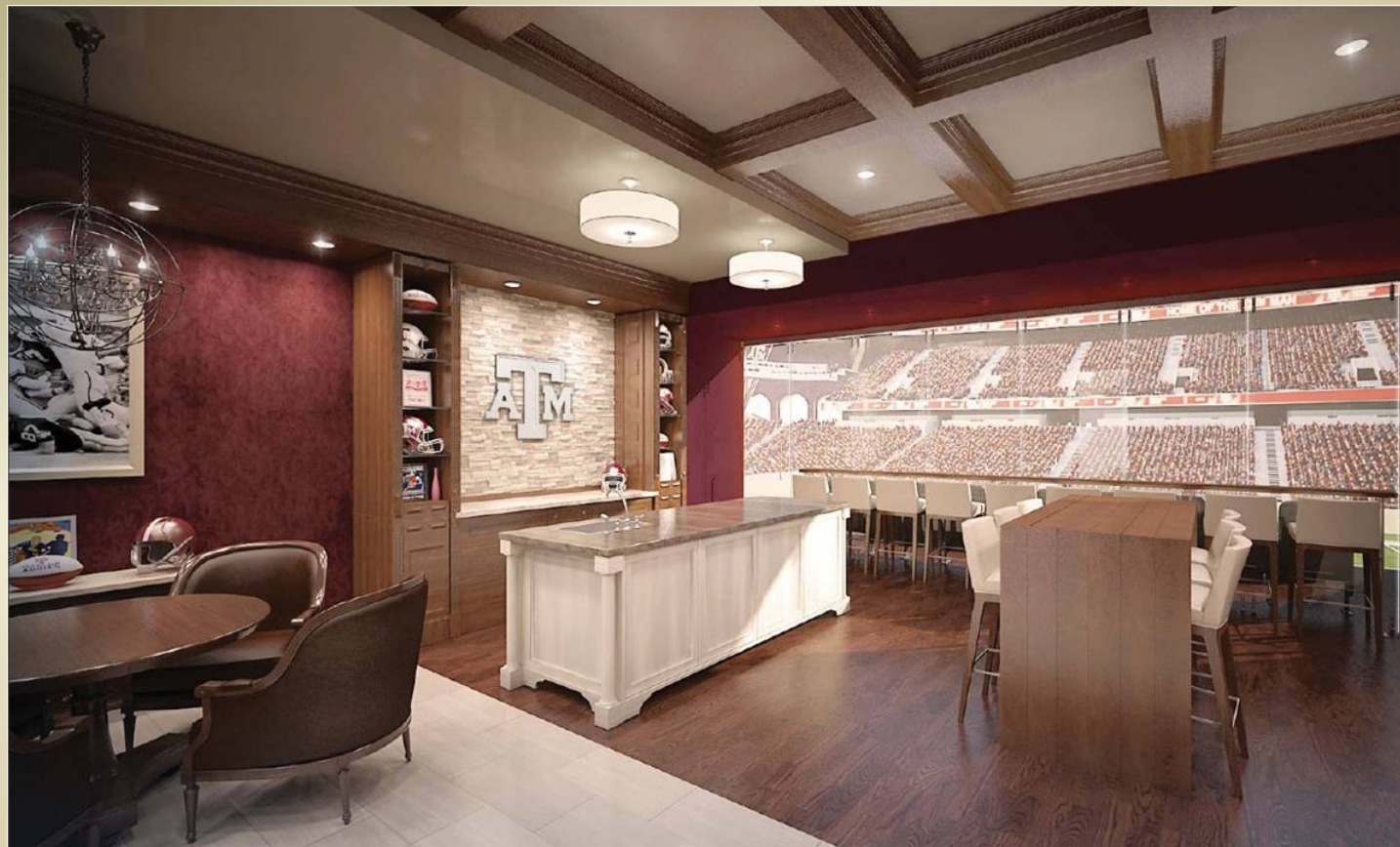
