Please bring this guide with you on your next doctor visit.

Express Scripts manages your prescription drug benefit for your employer, plan sponsor, or health plan.
Medco is now a part of the Express Scripts family of pharmacies.

Preferred Prescriptions®/RX Selections™ is a formulary list of medications that may be covered under your prescription drug plan. This list was reviewed by an independent group of practicing doctors and pharmacists, and it contains medications made by most pharmaceutical manufacturers. It includes medications for many covered conditions.

SAVING MONEY ON PRESCRIPTIONS

Your plan may prefer some medications over others. These are called *preferred drugs*.

You may pay:

- Lowest co-payment/co-insurance for generic drugs
- Higher co-payment/co-insurance for preferred brand-name drugs
- Highest co-payment/co-insurance for nonpreferred brand-name drugs

Your doctor may be able to help you save money by prescribing generic and preferred brand-name drugs if appropriate. So be sure to bring this guide with you on every visit to your doctor. Some commonly prescribed nonpreferred drugs are also listed in this guide for your reference.

Please note: This guide does not contain a complete list of formulary and nonformulary drugs. It only lists the *most commonly prescribed drugs*. Visit Express-Scripts.com anytime to check the price and coverage of medications under your plan. - G Means a preferred generic medication
- P Means a preferred brand-name medication
- NP Means a nonpreferred brand-name medication



