

### Your Medco Prescription Drug Plan



- Medco administers your prescription drug plans on behalf of the A&M Care plan.
- Benefit includes both a retail and mail component
- Medco has its own mail-order pharmacy **Medco By Mail** where specialist pharmacist focus on compliance and lower cost options for the patient, and the automated filling system ensures the prescription is filled accurately.\*
- Medco's mail-order pharmacies fill about 2 million prescriptions per week through a highly automated process that is 99.9997% accurate and is 23 times more accurate than a retail pharmacy

Retail – 30 Day Supply: Refills allowed as prescribed. (Good option for new prescriptions)	\$10	\$35	\$60
Retail – 90 Day Supply: Refills allowed as prescribed	\$30	\$105	\$180
Medco By Mail Pharmacy: Up to a 90-day supply*. Refills allowed as prescribed (Best option for maintenance medication)	\$20	\$70	\$120


<sup>\*</sup> If you obtain a brand-name drug when a generic equivalent is available, you are responsible for the generic copayment plus the cost difference between the brand-name drug and the generic drug. 
#### **Medicine Cabinet**

# Generics Rx Advantage Waiver Opportunities

Generics Rx Advantage Includes Two Types of Waiver Opportunities\*:

#### **Generic Copay Waivers**

- Full copay waivers for a 3-months supply for new\* generic prescriptions at the Medco Pharmacy, including:
  - > Any brand prescription (retail or mail) submitted as a generic at mail;
  - > Retail generic prescriptions moved to mail;
  - > New generic prescriptions submitted at mail

#### Off-patent Copay Waivers

- Copay waivers (up to \$25) for selected brand prescriptions that will soon become generic, when these prescriptions are moved from a retail pharmacy to the Medco Pharmacy
- Off-patent copay waivers will be available 6 months prior to the expected generic launch of selected brands.

You must respond to Medco in order to participate in the program and be eligible for waivers

### Worry-free Fills™

- Worry-free Fills<sup>™</sup> is an automatic refill program available to A&M Care members who utilize the Medco Pharmacy.
- Members enroll for the program at the drug level.
- If you choose to enroll a particular medication, a reminder letter is either mailed or emailed to you approximately three weeks before the prescription is filled.
