If you are gñi kdr'qt 'dgeo g'gñi kdr'ht 'O gf lect g, it is very important for you and cp{ 'hvj gt covered O gf lect g/gñi kdr'f gr gpf gpw'vq'gpt qnlk'both Parts A and B of Medicare.

Your A&M System coverage will be pgi cwxgn affected if you do not enroll in both Parts A and B of Medicare. When you or your spouse are eligible for Medicare, (as of the first of the month in which you turn age 65) your A&M System plan becomes **ugeqpf ct** to Medicare coverage. If you are already 65 or older when you retire, you should **immediately** contact your local Social Security office to enroll. You qt'c'f gr gpf gpv'may be eligible for Medicare gctrkt'vj cp age 65 if you have dggp'f kcdrgf "and j cxg"dggp"cy ctf gf Social Security benefits for 24 months.

Medicare Part A is free hospitalization coverage. Medicare Part B, which has a monthly premium, covers doctor's services, outpatient lab and X-ray services, medical equipment, etc.

When you enroll in Medicare Parts A and B. and are not working for The Texas A&M University System, you may be eligible for the 65 Plus plan, which is rñg'c Medicare supplement plan. If you'eqxgt'f gr gpf gpw on your health plan, you and {qw'f gr gpf gpw must be gñi kdr'cpf 'gptqmgf 'kp'O gf lectg'to take advantage of this plan.
