## Workday Updates

- Going into Production this afternoon (6/12):
  - Premiums for FY26
  - ACA Configuration for FY26 (measurement period ending 6/30/25)
  - New Report: Employees Certifying Other Medical
    - Includes email addresses
    - Use to communicate with employees how to update their OBQs prior to OE launching if their situation has changed

## Workday Updates

- Open Enrollment in Workday Updates:
  - We plan to host weekly virtual meetings beginning the week of 7/14 to allow for questions and updates
  - All new full-time employees with an SGIP date driver of "C" and hire date between 8/2-9/1/2025 will be put into a Non-OE benefit group
    - This group previously only included 9/1 hires
    - If an employee begins benefits mid-August, they will need an Alternate Open Enrollment Event
    - A reporting solution will be available before August to help identify any employees missing OE events



## **BCBSTX Network Update**

- Shannon Medical Center Texas has rescinded their termination notice
- There will be no interruption of in-network care to our employees/retirees.
- Also, will still be in network for the 65 Plus Medicare Advantage Plan (PPO)

# 65 Plus Medicare Advantage Plan Update



#### Medicare Cards

Medicare Cards should be submitted via ticketing system to SBA. Workday is not a
document management system, and they should not be uploaded into Workday. Our
official insurance master file is HRConnect and that is where these documents should
live.

#### CMS Reports – RFI Status (Request for Information)

- Once RFI is determined, the member is put in RFI Status and worked within 21 days from file submission, utilizing 3 calls including a letter. RFI Status holds up the CMS approval and if not received the member will show on the CMS report as "member is termed never effective for no response to RFI".
- RFI Status Reasons: Missing Part A and B, Bad MBI, and/or Invalid Permanent Address.
- Ensure there is a physical address in Workday for the retiree & dependents (if enrolled) when entering Medicare information OR moving to 65 Plus Medicare Advantage Plan.

If we don't get this information by June 14, 2025, we will have to deny your request to enroll in our plan.

If you are calling from April 1 through September 30, alternate technologies (for example, voicemail) will be used on weekends and holidays.

  - 7/1/2025 will exclude 22 additional products from the NPF
  - Full list of changes is available online <u>July 1 Exclusion List</u>
  - Current full list of exclusions is available online and will be updated on 7/1 to include all changes – <u>2025 NPF Exclusions</u>

- FY23 Closed All payments made, thank you!
- FY24 Closed 2 of 4 invoices have been paid thank you!
- FY25 in progress currently there are 59 discrepancies

#### **Annual Grandchild Certification**

- Total Dependent Grandchildren to be recertified: 149
  - 95 recertifications complete
  - Benefit Partners can run the Employees and Retirees with Dependent Grandchildren report for live updates
- Process began Tuesday, 4/08/2025
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> notice emails were sent out on 5/6/2025
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> and final notice was sent out 06/06/2025
  - Deadline to submit documentation 06/30/2025
- Forms and tax returns should be sent to SBA for processing and imaging via the ticketing system – <u>please do not upload to HRConnect</u>
  - SBA will collect the Grandchild Certification documentation and update Workday
  - If you receive the forms, be sure to confirm dependent is listed on the certification form and the current filed 2024 tax returns
  - 2024 tax returns must include signature pages OR the e-file confirmation

### Wellness Credits



#### Wellness Exam Completion Missing?

1. Ask the member if they can locate the wellness visit in the "Health Record" section of their WebMD portal (note: this is separate from the Dashboard Incentive area). This helps determine whether the issue is related to the claim processing or if it's a recognition issue on WebMD's end.

#### OR

2. Ask the member to provide the EOB for the visit. This will serve as sufficient documentation and replaces the need to check the Health Record.





## The Invitational Step Challenge




# System Insurance Billing

- July 2025 invoices will generate on 6/17/25, and paper bills will be mailed via USPS on 6/18/25. (Due to Emancipation Day Holiday)
  - Invoices are created mid month, mid week
  - All Benefit Events that may affect billing require a support ticket submitted to SBA at <a href="mailto:sba-support@tamus.edu">sba-support@tamus.edu</a> with the subject 'Billing Update//Name//UIN'.
  - Changes to any active ACH/TRS invoice will require a support ticket submitted to IB 24 hours prior to the last working day of the month.
- Customers profiles refresh nightly from Workday to the Billing App.
- Benefit events completed outside of the 90-day event date window will not update to IB. Member will show as ineligible.
- Participants must be in a billing eligible position.
- IB cannot bill for less than a full month's premium or bill separate line-item benefits.

## Life Insurance Reminders



#### **Death Processing Updates:**

- Hartford Update: For employee and retiree life insurance claims (WNOD), the Hartford will now provide the death certificate to SBA directly.
- Dependent deaths: Workstations should continue to request death certificates for dependents who are removed from benefits (death certificate is required documentation for QLE).
- Death of Employee benefit events: use the actual date of death for the benefit event, unless the death occurred on the first of the month, then use the 2<sup>nd</sup> of the month
- The order of steps is what ensures the benefits terminate on the last day of the month.
- HR 113 Form (WNOD): Always use the most current HR 113 Workstation Notice of Death form from the protected website.

#### Reminders



- If employees/retirees are reaching out to you regarding an issue with a claim, eligibility, etc. submit a ticket to <u>sba-support@tamus.edu</u>
- When rescinding/redoing benefit events or correcting existing benefit events – please be sure to add descriptive comments/remarks. If an SBA ticket is related to the change you made, please include the SBA ticket number.
