



Exceptions to the Licensed Carry of Concealed Handguns at Texas A&M University-Central Texas

In accordance with state law, the licensed carry of concealed handguns will be allowed at Texas A&M University-Central Texas beginning on August 1, 2016. After consulting with students, staff members, and faculty, the following exceptions were proposed that take into account specific safety considerations of the Texas A&M University-Central Texas environment. The proposals were reviewed by the Texas A&M System Office of General Counsel, approved by the Chancellor for submission to the Board, and were considered and accepted by the Texas A&M System Board of Regents on April 27, 2016.
