10. Each system member, not SRS (formerly OSRS), is responsible for export control compliance.
9. Faculty and researchers are targeted through email solicitations.
8. Foreign Travel – employees taking research or university-owned equipment.
7. Basic security- locking or securing facilities and controlled equipment.
6. Lab access- improperly issuing IDs that allow unauthorized access.
