Policy Statement

This policy allows for the designation of a property that has historical significance.

Reason for Policy

This policy allows for a member of The Texas A&M University System (system) to safeguard and preserve its historical heritage.

Procedures and Responsibilities

The system Board of Regents (board) may, upon the recommendation of a system member chief executive officer and concurrence of the chancellor, designate a specific physical property for preservation because of its historical significance.

Upon the board's designation of a property, the system member may seek to have the property designated as a Recorded Texas Historic Landmark and/or included on the National Register of Historic Places.

Rehabilitation and renovation of properties designated under this policy shall conform to established guidelines.
