

System Regulation 34.06.02, Weapons

Definitions

Campus – means all land and buildings owned or leased by a member.

Chemical dispensing device – a device, other than a small chemical dispenser sold commercially for personal protection, that is designed, made, or adapted for the purpose of dispensing a substance capable of causing an adverse psychological or physiological effect on a human being. *See* Tex. Penal Code § 46.01(14).

Handgun – any firearm that is designed, made, or adapted to be fired with one hand. *See* Tex. Penal Code § 46.01(5).

Illegal knife – any of the following: a) a knife with a blade over five and one-half inches; b) a hand instrument designed to cut or stab another by being thrown; c) a dagger, including but not limited to a dirk, stiletto, and poniard; d) a bowie knife; e) a sword; or f) a spear. *See* Tex. Penal Code § 46.01(6).

Premises – a building or a portion of a building. The term does not include any public or private driveway, street, sidewalk or walkway, parking lot, parking garage, or other parking area. *See* Tex. Penal Code § 46.035(f)(3).

Prohibited weapon – an explosive weapon; a machine gun; a short-barrel firearm; a firearm silencer; a switchblade knife; knuckles; armor-piercing ammunition; a chemical dispensing device or a zip gun. *See* Tex. Penal Code § 46.05(a). These individual terms are defined in section 46.01 of the Texas Penal Code.

Weapon – a firearm, illegal knife, club, or prohibited weapon as defined in this regulation. *See* Tex. Penal Code § 46.03(a).
