Course Announcement – May 25, 2023

Dear A&M System Training Coordinators,

TrainTraq course <u>11013</u>: Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI-DSS), has been updated to the latest standards and is now titled, "PCI-DSS for Merchants." The course was developed by a vendor. It reviews the PCI-DSS standard and is required for Texas A&M System employees who accept debit/credit card payments or are responsible for some part of the processing of card transactions.

Employees who've taken 11013 in the past will see the updated course name on their TrainTraq transcript. It is equivalent.

In addition, Financial Management Operations at Texas A&M University has purchased an update to their course, <u>2112477</u>: PCI-DSS for Cashiers from the same vendor. This course satisfies the PCI-DSS requirement for security awareness training and is designed strictly for cashiers who accept credit/debit cards as a form of payment, but who do not answer questions on the annual PCI Self-Assessment Questionnaire nor control IT systems in scope for PCI. It is available for other System members to use.

Most System members have automated assignment rules for <u>11013</u>: PCI-DSS for Merchants. All current assignment rules and course reports remain the same, and there is no action required.
