I'm pleased to announce that a new online course, [International Travel Safety: Safe Passage Presentation](#) (course no. [2111728](#)), has been added to TrainTraQ. This course is designed to educate Texas A&M University System employees and students on safety and awareness while traveling overseas.

The course consists of a video and a quiz, based on content provided by a vendor (Center for Personal Protection & Safety). The quiz is intended as a review tool; no score is recorded, but employees will need to finish the quiz to get credit for completing the course.

The course will not be required at the System level. However, the System Risk Management Office highly recommends that all faculty, staff, and students complete this course prior to travelling internationally. Please work with the Risk Management office at your System member to determine how best to use these courses at your university or agency.
