The System-required course, Information Security Awareness (3001), has been updated with content related to preventing imposter fraud when initiating or approving financial transactions.

As mentioned in prior System Training Coordinator meetings, a new course, Fiscal Transactions - Preventing Impostor Fraud (2114125), was to be required of all System employees. Upon receiving input from System members, the content was reviewed, and it was decided the content related to all employees would be added to the Information Security Awareness course.
